Subject: Please introduce the PURGE Act — the EFTA enforcement bill is already drafted

I am a constituent writing about the Epstein Files Transparency Act (Pub. L. 119-38) and the enforcement legislation that is now ready for introduction in both chambers.

EFTA passed the House 427–1. The Department of Justice released less than one percent of records by the statutory deadline. The Inspector General opened a compliance audit. Files already released have been pulled back and re-redacted with no notice. National security counsel has stated publicly that EFTA "did not incorporate any enforcement mechanism."

A drafted bill — the **Predator Unmasking, Restitution, and Government-wide Exposure Act of 2026 ("PURGE Act")** — is available at anazaosolutions.com. The full bill text, section-by-section constitutional analysis, sponsor one-pager, and press packet are released under an open license. The drafter — Anazao Solutions LLC, based in Idaho — asks for no credit, no compensation, and no acknowledgment. Any Member of Congress may introduce, adapt, or amend the bill without permission and without attribution.

The bill is structured to be passable:

- **No new criminal felony.** No monetary fine. No prison sentence.
- The consequence for a knowing and willful violation of EFTA is removal from office, ten-year disqualification, pension forfeiture, and Bar referral — modeled on the Hiss Act framework.
- DOJ line attorneys are protected from retaliation.
- An asset freeze prevents the conspiracy estate from being sold or commercialized while litigation proceeds.

My ask: Please consider introducing the PURGE Act, co-sponsoring it once introduced, or requesting a hearing on EFTA implementation failures from the House or Senate Judiciary Committee. The bill text is ready. The drafting credit is not yours to give back — it has already been waived.

I am asking on behalf of the survivors who have waited two decades for an accountability framework, on behalf of the 427 Members who voted for EFTA, and on behalf of the public interest in a federal disclosure law that actually carries consequence.
